

High Representative Views Summit as Historic Opportunity

The High Representative, Paddy Ashdown, today gave his full support to the summit of the heads of state of Croatia, Yugoslavia and Bosnia and Herzegovina, which will take place in Sarajevo on Monday. This is the first such meeting in Sarajevo and represents a historic opportunity to open a new chapter in the relations among these three countries. The time has come to focus efforts on the road ahead, which leads to integration in the European mainstream, the High Representative said.
