

Bulldozer Committee Proposals Adopted

Voluntary membership in FBiH Craft Chamber proposed

[P.4] FBiH Government session that took place on Monday was fully dedicated to implementation of the Bulldozer Committee proposals for laws that should improve implementation of economic reforms and creation of a favorable business environment.

By defining proposals yesterday that shall be sent to the FBiH Parliament for adoption in an urgent procedure and by passing of rulebooks, the Federation government fulfilled obligations of FBiH to the Bulldozer Committee, the FBiH Press Office announced, Fena reported.

Required changes in the area of claims on bank accounts were implemented with the defined law proposal for amendments to the Law on executive procedures.

The proposed amendments to the FBiH Law on chambers of commerce anticipate six-month interim period, when new legal provisions shall be implemented.

This was done so that chambers of commerce are able to transform and start functioning based on the new organization, as the key change in the Law is abolishing of compulsory membership in chambers of commerce.

Membership in the FBiH Craft Chamber shall also be voluntary, instead of the existing compulsory membership, according to the proposed law on amendments to the Craft Law.
