Bulldozer Committee

Exporters Breathe More Easily

The Committees have been formed, including a committee for agriculture

BANJA LUKA – The Coordinator of the Bulldozer Committee for Banja Luka region, Mladen Micic said yesterday that the RS economy would benefit from measures that were passed on the committee plenary session in Sarajevo two days ago.

As the most important measures, he mentioned introducing of fuel quality standards, removing roadblocks in sales of stocks for small stockholders, environmental protection, wood industry and wood supply in BiH.

“We failed to put a ban on export of raw logs from BiH, but we managed to put this issue under control,” Micic told Srna.

As important measures, he mentioned establishing of BiH Veterinary Chamber, removing monopoly in implementation of marketing campaigns and facilitating export by simplifying internal processing procedures or the so called “import for export.”

Micic said that the next Bulldozer Committee Plenary session would take place in Banja Luka and that another 15 reforms would be analyzed at the session.
